## 86G87 performs on two soil types

Kajewski's have grown Bonus.MR grain sorghum for a number of years achieving good results. This year on "Bettafield" they chose 86G87 because the country is a lighter brigalow scrub soil and they wanted a slightly quicker maturity. About 250 hectares sown on their best country achieved a paddock average of 3.3 tonnes per hectare. This result equalled MR.Buster and was ahead of MR43 grown on the same 18 month fallow. Steve Kajewski said that the 86G87 performed really well on a further 120 hectares of harder country achieving a yield of 2.5 tonnes per hectare, a result that was well above expectations. Steve was very happy with the fact that 86G87 performed well on both soil types.

This crop was planted at 50,000 seeds per hectare on 18 inch rows and achieved an established population of 30,000 plants per hectare. Atrazine was applied post emergent by air.
