



Bonus.MR produces for Emerald grower

Last season Gary Sanders planted Bonus.MR for the first time. The Bonus was planted in September with Gary establishing 50,000 plants per hectare. The previous crop was chickpeas. Gary applied 100 kg/hectare of urea using both ground application and water-run. He watered the crop three times using approximately 3 ML per hectare. The spring crop averaged 6 tonnes per hectare.

Gary then ratooned the crop in the summer and applied another 100 kg/hectare of urea and watered three times as well. "The good rain after the first harvest really helped the crop come away well," Gary said. This crop went well averaging 6 tonnes per hectare. The grain quality was great.

Phil Murphy from Hygrain, who supplied Gary's Bonus seed said, "Bonus was an excellent variety for this situation and considering the amount of nitrogen applied, it yielded extremely well."
