Matthew planted Liberty under the Pivots as well as come 86G87 and new G56. The G56 was also planted on a dryland paddock nearby. Matthew chose Liberty because of the feed quality of the grain, as local producers have recorded best ever feed gains on sorghum while feeding Liberty. The white grain offers better utilization of the grain over red sorghum.
